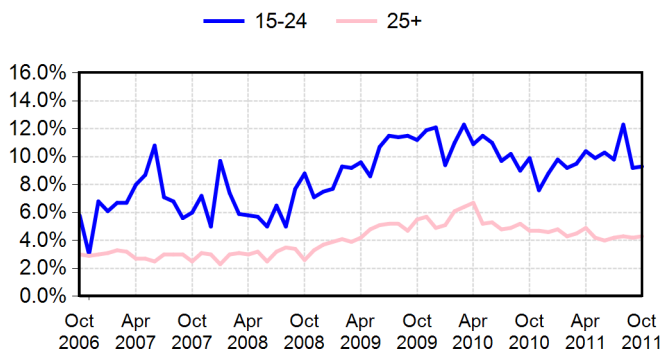

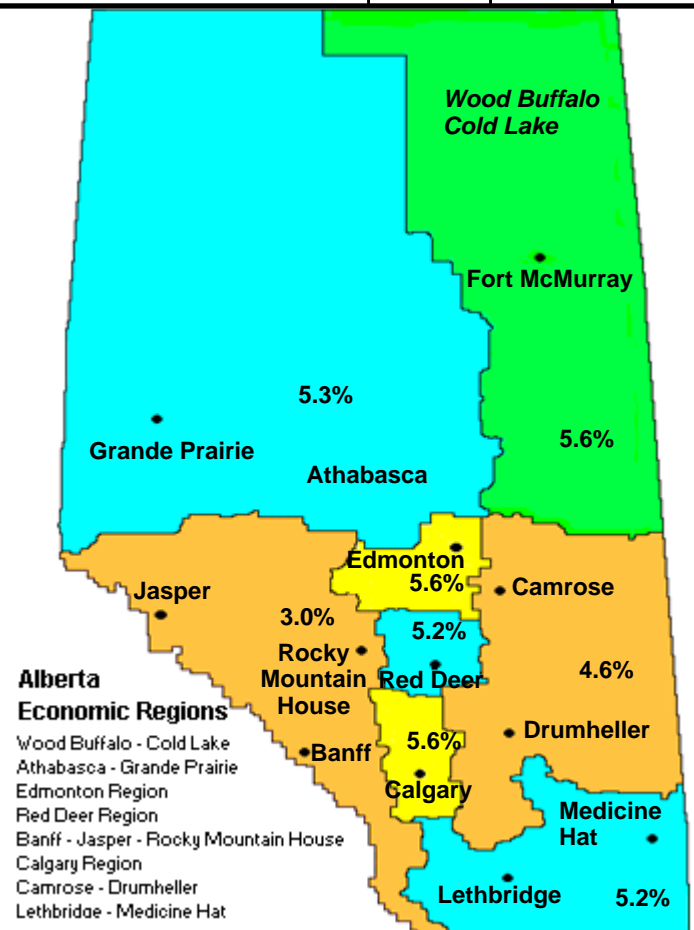
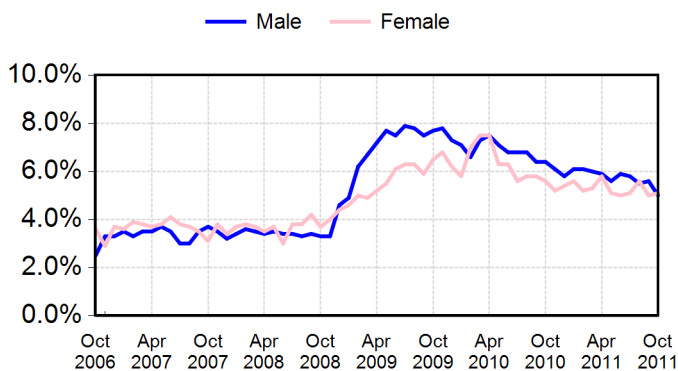

#### Unemployment Rate by Age & Gender, Alberta Seasonally Adjusted



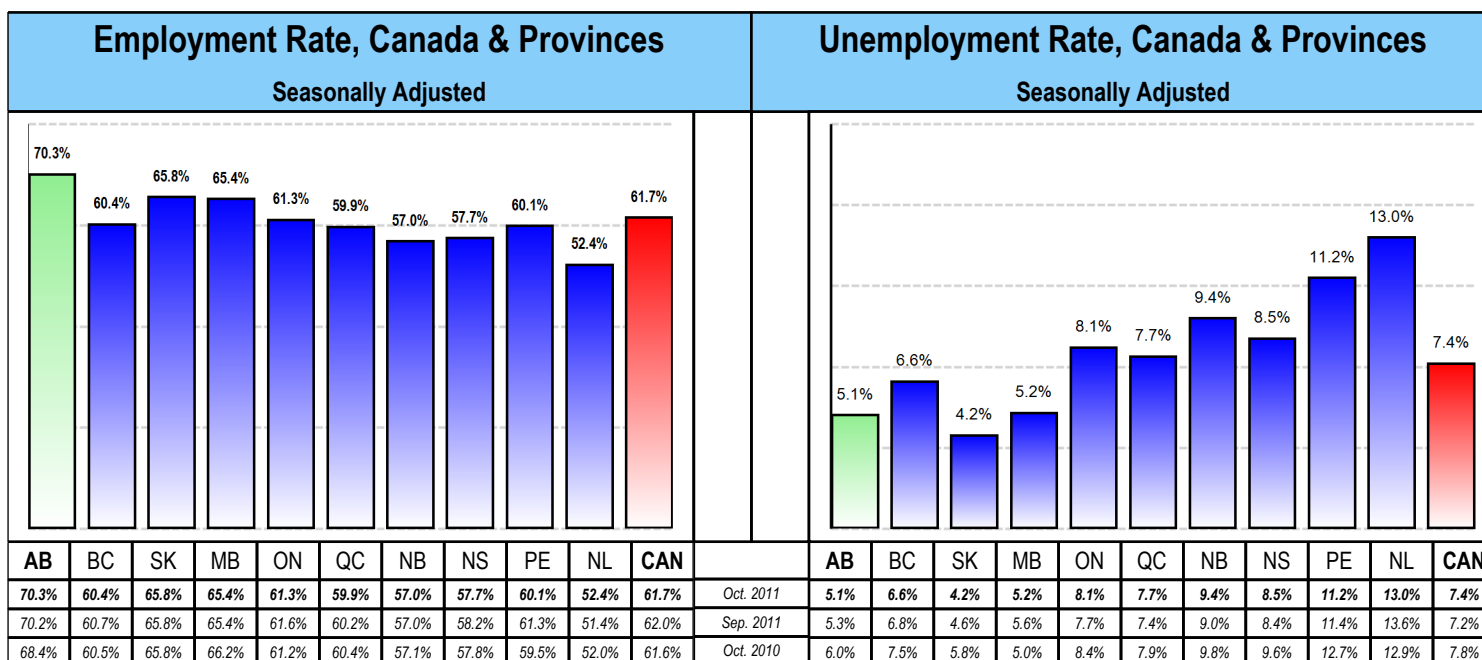
