

Quebec/Alberta Student Employment Exchange

Program

To provide summer employment opportunities with the Québec and Alberta provincial governments for students in a university program. These positions must offer:

- meaningful work experience related to the student's field of study
- the opportunity for students to enhance their second language skills
- the opportunity to experience and learn about the culture of the other province

Eligible employers

The provincial government departments of Alberta and Québec.

Responsibilities of the Québec and Alberta Governments

The Government of Québec is responsible for recruiting, interviewing and selecting Québec students for positions in Alberta. The Quebec Ministry of Industry and Commerce arranges and pays for round trip airfare to Alberta for Québec students.

Alberta Human Services is responsible for recruiting, interviewing and selecting Alberta students for positions in Québec. Alberta Human Services pays for round trip airfare to Québec for Alberta students.

Alberta students must:

- be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada
- be a resident of Alberta for the past six months

- be a full-time student in a university program in Alberta
- have completed at least one year of post-secondary education
- be planning to continue their studies at a post-secondary institution in the fall
- have a working knowledge of the French Language

Application deadline and employment period

The deadline for applications is the end of January every year. Employment is for 13 weeks beginning mid-May until mid-August. Salary is \$15 per hour for 35 to 40 hours per week.

Transportation and living costs

- Students travel as a group to Québec. Round trip airfare is arranged and paid for by the Alberta government
- Housing and living expenses are the responsibility of the student
- The Québec staff will assist Alberta students in finding accommodation
